14 schools have registered, with many having multiple teams that want to participate. Ann also had a small private school contact her that will have one team participate. Josh will contact St. Nicholas School to promote the event. Dennis will determine how to limit the number of participating teams from each of the schools. Only two teams from each school will be able to place in the top three winning spots.

Dennis has had difficulty setting up practices at Edison Middle School, as his contact is no longer working there. He hopes to host at least one practice before the 2/17/2024 competition. Ann shared that the NCMMA may be able to fund a different practice site if needed.

The challenge apparatus is almost complete. The score sheets will be adjusted once the challenges have been finalized. Approximately 15 volunteers will be needed the day of the event to judge the challenges and presentations. Jerry will see if any of his Navy recruiting contacts are available to volunteer. Ann will also be recruiting for volunteers.

The Navy League has approved a \$1,000 sponsorship for the first place winning team, with the NCMMA sponsoring \$500 for the second place team. Ann will follow-up with Nate Millsap for possible snack donations. Cruisers and FMG reps will donate company promotional items for approximately 20 student winners.
