PLAN: SEAPERCH COMPETITION – MARCH 1, 2025 – ASHWAUBENON COMMUNITY POOL

Up to 13 teams will be participating in Saturday's, 2/15/2025, pool practice at Edison Middle School (Green Bay). The mission courses have been fully built. The practice will determine how well the courses work, allowing time for any adjustments.

7 team slots are available of the 20 that were offered. There are a couple of new schools participating this year. Allowing one extra team per school, if needed, is considered a fair adjustment to cap the number of teams. The regional competition will have judges at both ends of the pool, with the mission courses located closer to the spectators. FMG, Cruisers Yachts, and potentially Burger Boat reps will be providing swag, enough for eight individual participants. Certificates will be printed and provided for first, second, and third place individual winners.

- ✓ After Saturday's practice, Dennis will establish the competition's schedule.
- ✓ Andrea Stromeyer and Dennis will review the scoring so it is aligned. Suggestions made after last year's competition:
 - Eliminate the '*Judges Comments*' sections from the obstacle and mission score sheets.
 - Double side, if not already one page, each of the score sheets.
- ✓ Ann has enough volunteers and will be following up with them. Jerry will also be following up with Navy volunteers.
- ✓ Dennis will send the schedule, score sheets, and any other event info to Ann by **Monday, February 24**.
- ✓ Ann will coordinate with Ashwaubenon's rep to have four pool lines, covering three lanes added.
- ✓ The core team and Navy reps are asked to be at the pool for setup by 7:00 a.m. the day of the event.
